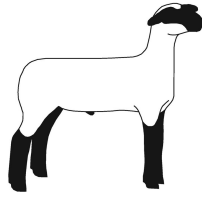


# 2020 PUTNAM COUNTY FAIR AGRICULTURAL FAIR OPEN YOUTH BREEDING SHEEP SHOW

### ENTRY DEADLINE:

Early Bird: Monday, **March 9, 2020**, by 5:00 p.m.  
(If mailing entry form, it must be post marked by Mar 9 2020)  
\*\* Can still register up to date of the show up to **1pm**. Late Fee will be charged.

### FAIR ARRIVAL:

Saturday, **March 21, 2020**, between 10 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.  
Tilton Arena, Use Back Entrance through main parking lot

### SHEEP SHOW:

Saturday, **March 21, 2019** @ 2:30 p.m.

### ENTRY FEES:

Early Bird Registration Fee of \$5.00 per animal (by 3/9/19)  
Late Registration Fee of \$10 per animal (3/10/19 through Day of Show)  
Showmanship \$5 (optional)

## RULES & GUIDELINES

1. Entry forms with notarized hold harmless and entry fees must be turned in by 5:00 p.m., Monday, **March 9, 2020**, for early bird registrations (or postmarked by **3/9/19**). Registration forms may be turned in up to day of the show with the Late Registration Fee.
2. Showmanship class is optional. A \$5.00 Showmanship entry fee is required to enter the showmanship class.
3. Animals must be checked in at the Putnam County Fairgrounds between 10 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. on Saturday, **March 21, 2020**, for Veterinary Inspection. A current health certificate, within 90 days, must be present at this time.
4. After arrival all exhibitors must check in at the Tilton arena livestock office by **1:00 p.m.**, Animals not checked in by this time, will be considered "No Shows" and will be deleted from the Show.
5. All Animals must be participating in the scrapies eradication program and provide U.S.D.A. visit [www.aphis.usda.gov](http://www.aphis.usda.gov) or your local veterinarian for information.
6. Animals must be in acceptable condition, trained to be handled and led.
7. Exhibitors must provide their own feed and water containers. Penning will be an open area where sheep must be tied on a chain provided by owner, portable pens are acceptable.
8. Premium money and awards should be picked up before leaving the show. The Putnam County Fair will not be responsible for awards and premiums not picked up.
9. Exhibitors are to use the Back Entrance through main parking lot.
10. Only the Exhibitor showing the animal will be admitted free. All helpers and family with exhibitor will be required to pay the fair admission fee.
11. The Putnam County Fair reserves the right to limit the number of entries.
12. In the Pee wee Showmanship Class all exhibitors will receive blue ribbons. This is a learning class; pee wee exhibitors may have one helper in the ring.

## CLASSES

Classes will be broken down the day of the show and will be placed in classes by weight.

\* Ribbons will be issued in each class in places 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>.

Division based on as of **September 1, 2019:**

Pee wee	Ages 5-7 *see rule #12 above.
Junior	8 – 10
Intermediates	11 – 13
Seniors	14 – 19

### Prizes awarded in each age division (except Peewee)

1 <sup>st</sup> place	Muzzle
2 <sup>nd</sup> place	Brush
3 <sup>rd</sup> place	Brush

## PREMIUMS AND AWARDS

All participants will receive modified Danish awards. Danish premiums are as follows: Blue \$4.00, Red \$3.00, White \$2.00

**Classes** will be placed and a ribbon will be given 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> places in each class.

To be awarded in each division (Black Face, White Face, Haired, AOB):

**GRAND CHAMPION** \$35.00, Trophy or Award

**RESERVE CHAMPION** \$20.00, Trophy or Award

**OVERALL SUPREME CHAMPION OF ALL BREED EWES** \$75.00, Lamb Blanket
